INFORMATION ABOUT THE VAT REFUND FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC

Having paid the conference fee, accomodation, and other services including the VAT on your invoices, you may ask for the VAT refund if you fulfil certain conditions:

- you must be VAT registered in your domicile
- domicile in EU, Switzerland or Norway
- you did not have a seat, place of enterprise nor a plant, nor a residency or a place, where you would usually reside and you did not perform a taxable event in Czech

If you desire VAT refund and fulfil the above mentioned conditions, please, send Contact information by fax or email to VAT.CZ s.r.o. Afterward you will receive closer information about the refund and all the necessary documentation.

When receiving an invoice, please, check your company details (name, address, VAT number). If they are not correct, require a correction. Final invoice must be also in Czech currency.
